



## **Official Rules of Entry Diamonds Direct Enchanted Engagement Raffle**

*Proceeds will benefit the continued beautification and preservation of New Orleans City Park's 1,300 acres.*

- The 2023 City Park Conservancy Diamonds Direct Enchanted Engagement Raffle is only open to legal US residents 21 years or older.
- City Park Conservancy Board of Directors, City Park Improvement Association Board of Commissioners, City Park Conservancy Staff, and their immediate families (living at the same household address) are not eligible for entry.
- A maximum of 2,000 entries will be sold.
- Only official ticket entries are eligible for the drawing. No facsimiles are permitted.
- Tickets may be purchased in the following manner:
  - **Mail:** City Park Conservancy Diamonds Direct Raffle, 1 Palm Drive, New Orleans, LA 70124. Do not send cash. Only check or money order can be included. All entries must be postmarked by November 10, 2023 to be eligible. Please allow five business days for the delivery of the US Mail. City Park Conservancy is not responsible for prompt delivery by the US Postal Service.
  - **Online:** <https://neworleanscitypark.org>. All online orders must be placed by Noon on November 17, 2023, to be eligible.
  - **Phone:** (504) 483-9376: Monday – Friday 9:00 until 5:00 p.m. (phone orders will end at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, November 17, 2023).
  - **In-person:** City Park Conservancy, #1 Palm Drive, New Orleans, LA 70124. Entries are accepted Monday – Friday 9:00 until 5:00 p.m.
- Winner will be determined in a random drawing to be held at Celebration in the Oaks Preview Party on November 18, 2023 at 8:00 p.m.
- Winner need not be present to win and will be notified by phone if not present.
- Winner must complete form W-9 and W-2G during transaction to City Park Conservancy's office by the close of business Wednesday, November 22, 2023 to receive the prize. City Park Conservancy reserves the right to determine sufficiency of identification. Income taxes for non-profit withholding are 31.58% (federal) and 6% (state) of vehicle value minus the \$50 ticket wager.
- Winner has 30 days to coordinate proposal with Diamonds Direct and Confetti & Co. Proposal must take place during Celebration in the Oaks 2023, which concludes on December 30, 2023.
- Winner will accept prizes "as is" and is solely responsible for all sales taxes, registration, insurance, and all other costs incurred in claiming, with the exception of income tax withholding.
- Two alternate names will be selected. Alternate, in the order selected, will be awarded the prize in the event the first winner does not comply and validly and/or timely claims the prize.
- Entry into the raffle constitutes permission for City Park Conservancy to use the winner's name and likeness for publicity purposes.

- The raffle is administered by City Park Conservancy with permission from the Louisiana Office of Charitable Gaming. All decisions concerning the raffle made by City Park Conservancy are final.
- Employees/agents of Diamonds Direct, Confetti & Co. and its dealers, its parent, subsidiaries, affiliates, promotional/advertising agencies and members of their immediate families (living in the same household address) are not eligible for entry and/or to win prize.
- The retail value of the prize has been determined by the donor(s) and has not been independently appraised by City Park Conservancy.
- The Prize may not be redeemed for cash, with no substitutes, other than if winner does not identify with a typical femme/female engagement ring, it will be an alternative to choose a band with Diamonds Direct of equal or lesser value.
- Winner agrees that City Park Conservancy is neither responsible nor liable for any warranty; representation or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law relative to the prize including, but not limited to, its quality, condition or fitness, except the ring does include Diamonds Direct limited warranty as set forth by Diamonds Direct.
